### **Drug Abuse: What Every Parent Should Know (1/8/2018 – 6 pm to 8 pm)**

This class provides information to parents about the current trends in dangerous drugs of abuse. Topics include signs and symptoms of a person abusing drugs and resources to consider if you suspect someone of using drugs.

### **Crime Prevention: Identity Theft, Scams & Frauds (1/22/2018 – 6 pm - 8 pm)**

Beware of potential scams and scammers. This class provides information about reality of identity theft, scams, and scammers. Information is provided to help educate persons to assist them in not falling prey to these predatory scammers.

### **Domestic Violence: Cycle of Abuse (02/05/2018 – 6 pm – 8 pm)**

Domestic violence affects individuals in every community regardless of age, economic status, sexual orientation, gender, race, religion, or nationality. Topics include the realities of people trapped in abusive relationships, the many hurdles that must be overcome to escape, resources available, and how police assist victims.

Information in a “hands on learning experience” is provided about the forensic science and the technology used at crime scenes to determine who committed the crimes.

This class educates persons about firearms, what to do if they find a gun, see someone with a gun, own a gun, and overall gun safety tips for those with firearms in their homes.
